



Scam and ID Theft Resource Sheet

Stay informed by setting up scam alerts:

- · Set up account alerts with your bank
- Sign up for VT-ALERT to get Vermont Scam Alerts: https://vem.vermont.gov/vtalert
- Sign up for Scam Alerts with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC): https://consumer.ftc.gov/scams & to view the list of previous alerts.

Routinely review your credit and financial statements:

Checking your credit report isn't just for adults — teens can have identity theft issues, too. Get your FREE credit report from each of the three credit bureaus at: https://www.annualcreditreport.com

When funds or personal information are stolen:

Step 1: Contact Your Bank (Immediately!)

Call your bank's fraud department – The sooner you call, the better chance they can stop the damage.

Step 2: Report the Scam

Submit an FBI Crime Report (IC3) report at <u>ic3.gov</u> or call 1-800-CALL-FBI. The sooner, the better!

Our FBI partners have indicated that ANY scam or fraud is worthy of reporting, regardless of type or size.

Step 3: Protect Your Identity

If personal information was stolen, <u>IdentityTheft.gov</u> provides step-by-step guidance.

And: Loop in a trusted adult or friend. You don't have to figure it out alone.
